## UTILISATION OF CSA 1'S TO UNDERTAKE STATION CLEANING

Following the station staff reviews and the implementation of new rosters a number of group relief CSA1's could not be translated to a CSA2 position. RailCorp proposed these positions be temporarily used for station cleaning under the control of Presentation Services Division.

The RTBU opposed this position. RailCorp have now advised that all CSA 1 positions will be paid at the CSA 2, 1<sup>st</sup> year rate.

During the period of the temporary utilisation for station cleaning the following will apply:

- The period you will be used in these cleaning duties on stations will not extend beyond March 2010 and it is possible that it will be shorter than this.
- You will remain on the Stations "Establishment".
- You are able to access overtime in station shifts subject to your cleaning roster obligations and normal overtime allocation processes.
- The Station Manager at your work location will continue to have accountability for you and your administration
- While you are involved in the nominated cleaning duties, the day to day work will be supervised by PSD in conjunction with the SM at your location. This will involve a short induction process prior to you undertaking these temporary duties.
- Whilst you are temporarily utilized in cleaning duties you will be paid at the higher CSA year 1 rate.
- You will continue to remain eligible for the normal translation process and movement to an approved station position in accordance with the Station Staff Review Translation Principles, within the above period.

Negotiations are continuing over CSA1's who have been acting in CSA2 higher duties to determine when they progress to CSA2, 2<sup>nd</sup> year rate.

Members affected should advise the Union of problems when rosters are implemented.
