**TO: STATE TRANSIT SALARIED RTBU MEMBERS**

## **NON PAYMENT OF UNIFORM ALLOWANCE**

Representations have been made by the Rail Tram and Bus Union to State Transit Authority over non payment of Uniform Allowance as per Clause 18 of the Salaried Officers Enterprise (State) Award 2009.

In Clause 18.3 of the Award it states “Operational Salaried Officers will receive a uniform allowance, which is paid annually into employees’ account on the anniversary of the initial issue for the procurement of State Transit uniform **from approved supplier/s**”.

Members have raised with the Union the fact that this Allowance has not been paid. The RTBU has been advised by State Transit that this is because the Tender for the supply of State Transit uniforms is currently underway. The closing date of Tender is 8 June 2010.

Until the contract is finalised and the supplier/s approved the allowance does not have to be paid. In the meantime the RTBU has been assured that Operational Salaried employees can apply for replacement of uniform, as well as personal protective equipment, in accordance with the State Transit Fair Wear and Tear Policy.

State Transit will advise the RTBU when Tenders for the supply have been finalised.
